PRESIDENT MOUL: Okay. Thank you, Senator Warner. We have a request for a call of the house. All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 16 ayes, 0 nays to go under call, Madam President.

PRESIDENT MOUL: The house is under call. Would all unexcused senators please return to the Chamber and record their presence. All unauthorized personnel must leave the floor. Would the senators please check in. Would the following senators please check in. Senator Ashford, Senator Nelson, Senator Pirsch, Senator Robak, Senator Conway, please check in. Senator Robinson. Senator Withem, please check in. Senator Lynch and Senator Rod Johnson. We're looking for Senator Rod Johnson. We will proceed with the vote on the motion to suspend the rules.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken. See pages 47-48 of the Legislative Journal.) 29 ayes, 8 nays.

PRESIDENT MOUL: The motion fails. I will raise the call.

CLERK: I have nothing further pending on the bill, Madam President.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. Senator Will.

SENATOR WILL: Madam President, I move the advancement of LB 1 to E & R for engrossment.

PRESIDENT MOUL: You've heard the motion to advance LB 1. All those in favor please say aye. Opposed nay. The ayes have it and the bill is advanced. And we will proceed with LB 2.

CLERK: Madam President, LB 2 was advanced this morning. I have a motion pending by Senator Moore to return LB 2 to Select File for specific amendment. (Moore amendment appears on page 48 of the Legislative Journal.)

PRESIDENT MOUL: Senator Moore.
