CLERK: (Record vote read. See pages 50-51 of the Legislative Journal.) 25 ayes, 4 nays, Madam President, on adoption of the Select File amendment.

PRESIDENT MOUL: The amendment is adopted. Senator Will.

SENATOR WILL: Madam President, I move the readvancement of LB 1 to E & R for engrossment.

PRESIDENT MOUL: We have a request for a machine vote. Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Madam President, members of the Legislature, I jumped the gun on the other one. That vote that we just took was to adopt the amendment, so when I said machine vote, it would have to occur anyway. On this one, again, I am going to vote against advancing this bill and I am going to vote against it anytime it comes for a vote, and I hope others will do the same. PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Chambers. We will proceed with the vote on the motion to advance to E & R. All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: A personal point, are we under a call, Madam President?

PRESIDENT MOUL: No, we are not under call.

SENATOR WARNER: I'd request a call of the house, to go under a call, and a roll call vote.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Warner. Request for a call of the house, all those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 23 ayes, 0 nays to go under call.
