CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on adoption of LR 5.

CLERK: Madam President, the first report is by Banking Committee with respect to the appointment of Mr. Bruce Bisson to the Nebraska Investment Council.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Senator Landis. Senator Conway, would you be able to handle this confirmation report since Senator Landis is not...oh, Senator Landis just arrived.

SENATOR LANDIS: Madam President, members of the Legislature, I rise to report the unanimous vote of the Banking Committee on the confirmation of Bruce Bisson as a member of the Nebraska Investment Council pursuant to an appointment by the Governor. I've been downstairs in the Workers' Compensation Task Force, just got up here. Bruce has been a member of the Advisory Forecasting Board on revenue for a year. He's a small businessman. He has sold software and hardware in the financial industry for a number of years. He's operated several businesses which have grown here in Nebraska, organized them and begun them, is a private investor, and has been responsible for determining the investment practices of the companies that he's operated. He appeared before the Banking Committee and answered questions from those assembled. And I would urge the adoption of his confirmation.
