CLERK: 6 ayes, 28 nays, Madam President, on the motion to return the bill.

PRESIDENT MOUL: The motion fails. Are there further motions on the desk, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: I have nothing further at this time, Madam President.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Okay, we will proceed with Final Reading on LB 1.

CLERK: (Read LB 1 on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT MOUL: We do have a request for a roll call vote, but first I have a request for a check in. Would the senators please check in. Senator Byars, Senator Chizek, Senator Pirsch, please check in, and Senator Schimek. Senator Chizek, please check in. Thank you. All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 1 pass with the emergency clause attached? Please proceed with the roll call vote.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken. See page 60 of the Legislative Journal for the Fourth Special Session.) 33 ayes, 13 nays, Madam President.

PRESIDENT MOUL: LB 1 passes with the emergency clause attached. We'll now move to LB 2.

CLERK: (Read LB 2 on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT MOUL: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 2 pass with the emergency clause attached? All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Read record vote as found on page 61 of the Legislative Journal for the Fourth Special Session.) 44 ayes, 0 nays, 3 present and not voting, 2 excused and not voting, Madam President.

PRESIDENT MOUL: LB 2 passes with the emergency clause attached. While the Legislature is in session and capable of conducting
