AN ACT relating to devises; to amend section 30-241, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to change an internal reference; and to repeal the original section.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. Section 30-241, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is amended to read:

30-241. With the exception of lands, money, or other property devised or bequeathed to this state for educational purposes which are controlled by Article VII, section 29, of the Constitution of Nebraska, the Governor, on behalf of the State of Nebraska, is authorized to accept devises of real estate or bequests of personal property, or both, made to the State of Nebraska, or any department or agency thereof, if in his <u>or her</u> judgment, under the terms on which such devise or beguest is made it is for the best interests of the State of Nebraska to accept the same.

Sec. 2. Original section 30-241, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is repealed.
