SPEAKER WITHEM: One minute.

Extracurricular activities are like golf, but when you have big-time college football that generates contracts with television networks for hundreds of millions of dollars, when you see big schools like Notre Dame and Penn State establishing their own television systems to produce their games and profit from them, you are dealing with business, and I want the young men who make it possible to be paid.

SPEAKER WITHEM: The Chair recognizes Senator Chambers. This will be your third opportunity to speak on this.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. Speaker and members of the Legislature, the reason I'm speaking again, I did not make it clear when I handed the paper to the young Page as to where it should go, but as soon as...oh, and it's back now. It went upstairs. That was my fault because I didn't make it clear what should have been done with it. I'm glad I didn't give it to one of my colleagues because they would have put it in a wastebasket so at least you saved it and for that I'm appreciative. I think I will let the amendment be offered and I will speak on it at that point.
