PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you, Senator Chambers. Is there any further discussion of the Chambers amendment? Seeing none, Senator Chambers, do you wish to close?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Yes, Madam President. Members of the Legislature, I am going to ask for a call of the house at this point, and that call can be taking place while I close, and it is not necessarily that I think everybody has to hear what I am saying, but it will save us a bit of time, so I am going to ask for a call of the house at this point.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you, Senator Chambers. There has been a request for a call of the house. All those in favor vote aye, all those opposed vote nay. Please record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays to go under call.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: The house is under call. Will all senators please return to their seats. Will all unauthorized personnel please leave the floor. The house is under call. Senator Chambers, you may proceed.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Thank you, and, Madam Chair, I am aware that my time was running while that was being done.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: No, it was not, Senator. We stopped the clock while we took the vote.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Oh, I thought...okay, but I am probably not going to use the full time anyway. All I want to do is make it clear that you are aware of what we are voting on. My proposed change to the rules would strike the language that gives explicit authorization to the Speaker to establish a consent calendar. As was pointed out by our present Speaker, under his authority to set the agenda, et cetera, he could do that anyway. But if you vote to keep this language in the rules, I am going to take it that you are voting to show me that you do, in fact,
