SPEAKER WITHEM: Any discussion? Any closing? Question is, shall LB 2 be advanced? All in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 29 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of LB 2.

SPEAKER WITHEM: LB 2 is advanced. LB 3.

CLERK. LB 3, introduced by Senator Hall as Chair of the board. (Read title.) Introduced on January 5, referred directly to General File, Mr. President.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Senator Hall, LB 3.

SENATOR HALL: Thank you, Mr. President and members. LB 3 would put a word that was deleted, during the Enrollment and Review process erroneously, back into the statute. The word is "spousal", so it would be added back into the section. I would move advancement to E & R of LB 3.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Is there any discussion? Seeing none, any closing? Closing has been waived. Question is, shall LB 3 be advanced? All in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Record.

CLERK: 31 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of LB 3.

SPEAKER WITHEM: LB 3 is advanced. LB 4.

CLERK: LB 4, offered by Senator Hall. (Read title.)

SPEAKER WITHEM: Senator Hall, LB 4.

SENATOR HALL: Thank you, Mr. President and members. LB 4 would transfer sections dealing with private postsecondary career schools that are now located in Chapter 79, they'd be transferred to Chapter 85. I'd move advancement to E & R Initial of LB 4.
