SPEAKER WITHEM: LB 6 is advanced. LB 7.

CLERK: LE 7 is offered by Senator Hall as Chair of the board. (Read title.) The bill was introduced on January 5, referred directly to General File.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Senator Hall, LB 7.

SENATOR HALL: Thank you, Mr. President and members. LB 7, as the Clerk mentioned, refers to LB 1066 that this Legislature passed last year, it deleted the prohibition on the investment of funds in South Africa. What the bill does is change the various sections in the investment of public funds and makes them consistent with the language that was found in LB 1066. I'd move advancement to E & R Initial of LB 7.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Any discussion? Any closing. Closing has been waived. Question is the advancement of LB 7. All in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Record, please.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President. on the advancement of LB 7.
