CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on the advancement of LB 12.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: LB 12 advances. LB 13.

CLERK: LB 13, by Senator Hall as Chair of the board. (Read title.) The bill was introduced on January 5, referred directly to General File.
