LB 14.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: LB 14 advances. LB 15.

CLERK: LB 15, introduced by Senator Hall as Chair of the board. (Read title.) Bill introduced on January 5, referred directly to General File, Madam President.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you. The Chair recognizes Senator Hall.

SENATOR HALL: Mr. Clerk, are we on LB 15 now?

CLERK: Yes, sir, we are.

SENATOR HALL: Thank you. Would hate to pass one of these controversial bills without having the right number up on the board. Madam President and members, LB 15 would repeal seven sections in Chapter 81; they deal with various things that are no longer needed, dates of 1981, '84, a section that even goes back to 1965, '89, '94 and '84, also a 1990, all of which are obsolete. For that purpose I would move to advance to E & R Initial LB 15.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you, Senator Hall. Is there any discussion of LB 15? Seeing none, closing is waived. The question before the body is the advancement of LB 15 to E & R Initial. All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Please record.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on the advancement of LB 15.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: LB 15 advances. LB 16.

CLERK: LB 16, by Senator Hall. (Read title.) The bill was introduced on January 5, referred directly to General File, Madam President.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you. The Chair recognizes Senator Hall.

SENATOR HALL: Thank you, Madam President and members. LB 16 takes two bills that were enacted in 1994, LB 414 and LB 872, correlates them to the sections as appropriate. It makes the changes necessary asked by those two bills that were passed by this body. I would move to advance to E & R Initial LB 16.
