I think more of the constitution than that and I will vote against this for the reasons that I have given and others that I will leave unstated, because, Senator Pirsch, even though I think this is the worst of the three, I'm not going to harry or hound yours any more than I did the others.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: One minute.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: In athletic contests if you score three goals like in hockey or soccer, they call that a hat trick, three strikes and you're out. This is my third strike and I may be out in one sense, but I'm not out of here I assure you.
