Warner, do you wish to close? Closing is waived. The question before the body is the adoption of the committee amendments to LB 202. All those in favor vote aye, all those opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? Please record.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of committee amendments.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Committee amendments are adopted. The Chair recognizes Senator Cudaback to open on LB 202.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Madam President, members, Senator Warner has adequately explained LB 202. It was brought to me by the treasurers and I do appreciate him amending it, making a better bill out of it. We all know what happened this past '93-94 with the interest being rather low on CDs and your savings, and there was a surge of people coming in to purchase the sale certificates due to the fact that they were paying such a large amount of interest. So it did cause the counties to pay an extra amount. The \$2 did not cover the sale, where the \$10 will adequately do such, and so I do urge your support for this LB 202, along with the amendments. Thank you.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you, Senator Cudaback. Is there any further discussion on LB 202? Seeing none, Senator Cudaback, do you wish to close? Closing is waived. CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on the advancement of LB 202.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: LB 202 advances. LB 28.

CLERK: LB 28 was a bill originally introduced by Senator Warner. (Read title.) The bill was introduced on January 5 of this year, at that time referred to the Government, Military and Veterans Affairs Committee. The bill was advanced to General File. I have no amendments to the bill, Madam President.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: The Chair recognizes Senator Warner to open on LB 28.

SENATOR WARNER: Madam President, members of the Legislature, LB 28 is a bill that was also introduced two, a year...two years, a year ago, I guess it was, and was advanced to General
