Will it be the district which would be Dodge County or would it be the district which is in Washington County?

SENATOR HARTNETT: Senator Janssen, I think it will be back to the receiving district, get the money from the state. It's just state money.

SENATOR JANSSEN: I realize that.

SENATOR HARTNETT: Mmm, hmm. And so that's how they...so it is...

SENATOR JANSSEN: But that would go back, that money would be received in that district in Washington County.

SENATOR HARTNETT: Yeah.

SENATOR JANSSEN: Right?

SENATOR HARTNETT: Yeah.
