

and improve it but I want you to be aware of it. Then you go on to say, upon a showing that such conduct is threatened. That is too vague. First of all, if you have a situation where somebody is going into court and telling the judge, I want an injunction because this kind of conduct is threatened, what do you mean by threatened? Who is threatening it? Are people out there right now who are going to do this kind of thing that you're asking me to enjoin? Again, overbroad and too vague. Then this final one. The conduct has occurred on a particular premises in the past. How long ago? Then you continue, and that it is not unreasonable to expect such conduct will be repeated. By whom? Injunctions are issued against people. If Abraham Lincoln did this, and he's dead, then because this is Abraham Lincoln's grandson, you want an injunction against him because Abraham Lincoln did this in the past? Mr. Speaker, I want to withdraw that amendment.

SPEAKER WITHEM: The amendment is withdrawn. Anything else?

CLERK: Yes, Mr. President, if I may. The Health Committee would like to have an Executive Session now in Room 2022. Health Committee, Room 2022 now. The next amendment I have, Mr. President, Senator Chambers, page 3, line 13, after the word "aid" add the word "or". (FA6 appears on page 492 of the Legislative Journal.)

SPEAKER WITHEM: Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Yes, Mr. Speaker, and members of the Legislature, Mr. Clerk, does it also have to strike something too?

CLERK: Strikes the...on line 18, in line 18. I should say, Senator, strikes the word "or accompany".

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Thank you. I wanted to be sure that I gave you the one that I intended to. Senator Elmer, on page 3, what I'm dealing with is language which makes it unlawful for anybody to accompany a person who is in violation of Section 2. And when you mention all the things that a person can do to be in violation, you don't say that the one who is going to be considered acting unlawfully knows about what's going on, is a party to what's going on, approves of what's going on, is accompanying the person for the purpose of trying to stop that individual. This is way too broad. And I want the record to
