So with that caveat, I will probably vote to advance but I want to look at it a little more. Here again, it's not a huge issue but, in terms of dollars perhaps, but I would like to look at it.

I know it's ridiculous, I know it's foolish, I wouldn't want to have to explain it if I'm on the campaign trail as to why I'm talking about children below
