

fourth generation until they are five years old. After they're five, all the curse is off. I can just see one of the senators who is going to vote for this. Well, my good friend, Senator Vrtiska, would go into his district and say, well, I think this is very good legislation to say that you can buy these for children under five, excellent legislation, a lifetime hunting, or fishing or combination, and Senator Beutler, in his district, saying the same thing. It was necessary for the Legislature to do this because Game and Parks told us they need money and this is a way to get it and we'll do anything that will get them some money. That probably is the most rational sounding argument that could be given because, on its merit, none of which this thing has, it cannot stand. So I'm going to ask for a call of the house, I'm going to get a roll call vote on my kill motion and if the motion is not successful, then it's not successful but we'll all be on record. And I will not continue to discuss this bill but I will bring it up from time to time during the session to show the wisdom, the intelligence of the Legislature and another example which demonstrates the validity of the theory behind the bell curve.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Thank you, Senator Chambers. I heard during your speech some reference to a call of the house and a roll call vote. Was that a request for those items? Okay. Question now is, shall the house go under call? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Record.

CLERK: 14 ayes, 0 nays to go under call.

SPEAKER WITHEM: The house is under call. Would members please return to the Chamber, record their presence. Senator Bromm, could you record your presence, please. CLERK: (Read roll call vote. See page 501 of the Legislative Journal.) 6 ayes, 34 nays. Mr. President.
