Closing is waived. The question is the adoption of the confirmation report. All in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of the first report offered by the Judiciary Committee.

SPEAKER WITHEM: The first report is adopted. Senator Hudkins.

SENATOR HUDKINS: Thank you, Mr. Speaker, and members, I misspoke on the last three persons. I said they were members of the Parole Board, they were members of the Crime Victims Reparations Committee. The next confirmation that we had concerned Mr. Ronald Barteo on the Parole Board, and that was a favorable confirmation from the committee, and so, therefore, we would suggest that you also confirm their appointment by the whole body with a record vote.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Thank you, Senator Hudkins. Any discussion? Any closing? Seeing no closing, we will move then to proceed to vote. All in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the approval of the confirmation report offered by the Judiciary Committee.

SPEAKER WITHEM: The confirmation report has been adopted. Item 6.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Schrock would move to withdraw LB 324.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Senator Schrock.

SENATOR SCHROCK: Mr. Speaker, members of the Legislature, I have a motion to withdraw LB 324 after discovery that it is a duplication of the senator...of a bill also offered by Senator Chambers. After careful consultation with my senior member in the body here, I have decided to withdraw the bill and let him take the lead on that. With that, I move that we withdraw LB 324.
