SPEAKER WITHEM: Any discussion? Closing? Closing, I assume has been waived. Proceed to vote on the motion to withdraw LB 324. All in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to withdraw the bill.
