SENATOR SCHMITT: Well, I don't have the law in front of me now but I don't believe right now they're required to have brake lights.

SENATOR JANSSEN: During daylight hours?

SENATOR SCHMITT: Any time.

SENATOR JANSSEN: Is that right?

SENATOR SCHMITT: I don't think so, but I would have to check the statute.

SENATOR JANSSEN: Maybe there's...

SENATOR SCHMITT: Brake lights are kind of vague.

SENATOR JANSSEN: Yeah. But it's a safety factor and unless someone can answer that question for me, why I would be looking for an answer to that. Thank you.

SENATOR WESELY: Thank you, Senator Janssen. The Chair recognizes Senator Schrock.

SENATOR SCHROCK: Senator Schmitt, just a few questions here. How does this affect a lot of things that farmers...I hate to use the word "things", a lot of trailers, implements that farmers pull on the highway, flatbeds, horse trailers, implements?

SENATOR SCHMITT: Farm implements are exempt during daylight hours, Senator Schrock. And they can't be out there after dark now without light.

SENATOR SCHROCK: Okay, so you don't think this is going to cause a problem for...

SENATOR SCHMITT: I don't think so. I talked to a lot of people on this. I talked to the fertilizer people and everybody was pretty much in agreement. This bill was worked on for two years and there was no opposition testimony, I don't believe, in Transportation, and I think it was pretty much worked out with everybody. There may be some questions on a few of those things
