

but, again, I think farmers are more concerned today with safety than they were, with the flashing lights on tractors and all this stuff, you know, out there. So I don't really believe it's going to be a problem. And this is the reason we did exempt that was for the same purpose because you can't hardly put lights on balers or this type of equipment out there that is operated during the daylight hours. And if you're out there after night then you're required to go to the clearance light part of those sections and those have to be out on the outside of the vehicle and most of that are the tires anymore and they haven't figured out a way to put lights on those. So that's the reason we exempted it like we did.

SENATOR SCHROCK: Thank you, Senator Schmitt. Senator Janssen, just a brief response to your question. For what it's worth, even when those fertilizer trailers are empty they generally outweigh the vehicle that's pulling them and there are no brake lights on those trailers or brakes on the trailers. So if you're following one of those vehicles, they're not going to stop very fast. I would yield to Senator Janssen if he has a question.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Yeah, Senator Schrock is yielding time to Senator Janssen.

SENATOR JANSSEN: Thank you, Mr. Speaker. It's been brought to my attention that all of these type of trailers, vehicles, and so on, have to have that slow moving vehicle sign on them, so that, I forgot about that, and that...maybe this would take care of that problem. When you see one of those trailers with that triangular sign on it why you're supposed to be cautious anyway. So that takes care of my problem with that.

SENATOR SCHROCK: Most of those trailers have a posted speed as to what they can be pulled. I'm not saying farmers observe that but they're not supposed to be pulled very fast either.
