SPEAKER WITHEM: Question is the adoption of the Bromm amendment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Senator Bromm.

SENATOR BROMM: (Microphone not activated immediately.) ...roll call vote.

SPEAKER WITHEM: The question is, shall the house go under call? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Record.

CLERK: 29 ayes, 0 nays to go under call, Mr. President.

SPEAKER WITHEM: The house is under call. Would members please return to the Chamber and record their presence. Unauthorized personnel leave the floor. While we're waiting for the members to check in, I would advise you that there will be four bills that will be...three bills that will be temporarily passed over on Select File because they have amendments. Those are 167, LB 28 and LB 175. We'll go through all of the other bills and then come back to those as time allows. Would also point out that LB 274 will be passed over today, we will not be taking up LB 274 at all. All of the others, at this point, there are no amendments filed on them and we'll be taking those up initially at the conclusion of this vote. Senator Lindsay, Senator Cudaback and Senator Schimek. Senator Fisher. Senator Lindsay. Okay, Senator Bromm has allowed us to go ahead. We cannot locate Senator Lindsay. Roll call vote in regular order. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken. See page 528 of the Legislative Journal.) 25 ayes, 17 nays, Mr. President.

SPEAKER WITHEM: The amendment is adopted. The call is raised. We'll move to Select File. LB 152, Mr. Clerk. Do you have any items for the record, by the way? Would you prefer to do that before we get started?
