

So those are the main things. And I discussed the security before, how that is open to the open records law. But basically it is a cleanup bill. It is things that they are doing now but they thought should be into statute except for the deputy director. That one they want to do without because that hasn't been filled. SPEAKER WITHEM: Discussion on the advancement of LB 343.
Senator Robak.

SENATOR ROBAK: Thank you, Mr. Speaker, members of the body, Senator Schellpeper, since this is a cleanup bill and just coincidentally I got a phone call just this very morning from a constituent that wanted an answer to a question and perhaps you can answer it for me. This constituent wanted to know if the payback for the scratch-off lottery tickets, how much is that payback right now?

SENATOR SCHELLPEPER: It can be whatever...

SENATOR ROBAK: But he wanted to know what it was. I mean is it 40 percent or 50 percent?

SENATOR SCHELLPEPER: It has to be at least 55 I think.

SENATOR ROBAK: Fifty-five, payback is 55 percent.

SENATOR SCHELLPEPER: At least that, at least. It can be more.

SENATOR ROBAK: It can't be more, can it?

SENATOR SCHELLPEPER: Oh, yeah.

SENATOR ROBAK: It can be more? Is that set statutorily or by the Department of Revenue, Gaming Division?

SENATOR SCHELLPEPER: I'll have to find that out because I really don't know...

SENATOR ROBAK: Would you do that, please, and also the payback for the pickles, how much is the payback right now at this time for pickles?

SENATOR SCHELLPEPER: That is 65.
