SENATOR FISHER: Mr. President, members, I just rise in support of this legislation, LB 64. Grand Island it would really help out because you'll see Don Shuda (phonetic) our veterans officer testifying and many times he has to take the application, send it back to the county in which the individual resided, then he has to sign it, then send it in so they can get admission, but it is a good piece of legislation and I ask you support it.
