

SENATOR HARTNETT: ...just the City of Lincoln.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Okay, thank you very much.

SENATOR HALL: Thank you, Senator Withem. Is there any other discussion on the adoption of the committee amendments? Seeing none, Senator Hartnett, do you care to close? He waives closing. The question is the adoption of the committee amendments to LB 36. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of the committee amendments.

SENATOR HALL: The committee amendments are adopted. Senator Crosby, to open on the bill.

SENATOR CROSBY: Mr. Chairman and members, LB 36 changes the requirements for the board for the examination of plumbers in primary class cities, and that in Nebraska is the City of Lincoln. Senator Hartnett has explained the bill to you because the committee amendments became the bill. This was brought to me because Lincoln's ordinance now has a broader area of coverage to include sprinkler systems and other areas which involve plumbing standards. I could take a lot of your time and go over everything that Senator Hartnett said, but in the interest of not taking up your time I'll just ask you to move the bill. Thank you.

SENATOR HALL: Thank you, Senator Crosby. Is there any discussion of the...excuse me, Mr. O'Donnell as Clerk of the Legislature has an amendment on the desk. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK. Mr. President, I might indicate, first of all, the Agriculture Committee, Chaired by Senator Dierks, would like to meet underneath the north balcony now.
