SENATOR HALL: Senator Kristensen, if you would respond.

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: Yes.

SENATOR MAURSTAD: Would this bill include attorneys?

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: You know, given the spirit in which you ask it, that if they were loitering about the outside of the fence, absolutely.

SENATOR MAURSTAD: Thank you.

SENATOR HALL: Any other questions regarding the bill, comments, discussion? Seeing none, Senator Kristensen, to close.

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: Thank you, Senator Hall and members of the Legislature. I suppose we could expand the definition to include the Clerk's desk and those that loitered around the front or sat near there would be included as well. But I guess we'll wait and see how they participate in that process. With that, I certainly appreciate the body's patience in sticking around right before the noon hour to advance the bill. Thank you.

SENATOR HALL: Thank you, Senator Kristensen. You've heard the close. Question is the advancement of LB 352 to E & R Initial. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of 352.

SENATOR HALL: LB 352 is advanced. Mr. Clerk, items for the record?

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Landis has amendments to 615 to be printed; Senator Chambers to LB 20. Hearing notices from the Revenue Committee, Judiciary Committee, Retirement Systems Committee and Health and Human Services, signed by the respective chairpersons.
