PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you, Senator Beutler. The Chair recognizes Senator Matzke.

SENATOR MATZKE: Madam President and members of the Legislature, it's my pleasure to recommend to this body the confirmation of the appointment of Tom Plummer of Brule to the Game and Parks Commission. Tom Plummer is a farmer and rancher, operates an irrigated farm, and cattle herd in western Nebraska. He is a graduate of the Nebraska Wesleyan University and still serves on their board of trustees. He has devoted himself to many very worthy endeavors during the period of his life and is truly dedicated to the protection and improvement of the recreational resources of this state and to our state parks and game and fish resources. He is an outstanding individual. I commend the Governor for appointing him and thank the Natural Resources Committee for recommending his confirmation without any dissenting vote. I would ask your approval of this appointment. Thank you.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you, Senator Matzke. Is there any further discussion of the Natural Resources confirmation report? Seeing none, Senator Beutler, do you wish to close. Closing is waived.
