

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Senator Jones.

SENATOR JONES: Madam President, I will withdraw that one.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: That amendment is withdrawn. Any further amendments?

CLERK: Yes, ma'am. Senator Warner has an amendment, Madam President, on page 527 of the Journal. (See AM0075.)

PRESIDENT ROBAK: The Chair recognizes Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: Thank you, Madam President and members of the Legislature. This amendment, first let me say, you will recall this is Senator Jones's bill which allowed for a county board to go back and recalculate levies if there was a clerical error made, and the amendment that we adopted on General File, yeah, General File with the committee amendments, was fairly short, it was a ten-day period. Senator Jones will have an amendment following this that will make that 30 days which is appropriate. The amendment I am offering strikes out a provision for a refund which, obviously, is not needed under the time frame that is going to be considered here because the adjustment for clerical error would be made prior to the time that any tax notices were sent out. So I'd move adoption of this amendment. It merely strikes the provision for a refund which no longer is needed.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Any discussion of the Warner amendment? Seeing none, Senator Warner, do you wish to close? Closing is waived. The question before the body is the adoption of the Warner amendment. All those in favor vote aye, all those opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? Please record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on adoption of Senator Warner's amendment.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: The Warner amendment is adopted. Is there any...

CLERK: Madam President...

PRESIDENT ROBAK: further...

CLERK: I am sorry, yes, there are. Senator Jones has an
