

that passed, as well as the one that Senator Lindsay has just proposed are both ones that will allow the Humane Societies to do their job without the impediments of being faced with possible jail time in the enactment of that charge of their duty. So I think this is an active responsibility. It is one that there are a number of ways it could be carried out, and I think it should be a minimum imposition to any of the legal trappers, and certainly they would also want to have some assurance that the good name of those legal and honest trappers is upheld. And I would urge the adoption of this amendment and thank Senator Lindsay and everyone who is paying attention, cooperating and making this a much more friendly bill to the Humane Society and to the domestic animals of our state. Thank you very much.
