

CLERK: Next amendment I have is by Senator Bernard-Stevens. Senator, AM0205. (Bernard-Stevens amendment appears on page 588 of the Legislative Journal.)

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Senator Bernard-Stevens. He wants to pull the amendment.
