SENATOR LINDSAY: Thank you, Senator Chambers. We are on Final Reading so all members are required to be in their seats. I would ask all members to please return to their seats, if they're not there, and to check in. Would ask all members to return to their seats, please, and check in. Senator Warner, Senator Bohlke, check in, please. Senator Chambers, Senator Preister, Senator Robak. Senator Elmer, Senator Hartnett. Senator Wehrbain, Senator Wesely, Senator Jones, Senator Kristensen, please check in. Senator Elmer and Senator Jones, would you return to the Chamber and check in, please. Senator Chambers, had you asked for a roll call or a board vote? Machine vote. The question is whether LB 202 should be returned to Select File for a specific amendment. All those in favor vote aye, those opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk. A record vote has been requested.

CLERK: (Record vote read. See page 659 of the Legislative Journal.) 6 ayes, 35 nays on the motion to return.

SENATOR LINDSAY: The bill is not returned. Is there anything further on the bill?

CLERK: Nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

SENATOR LINDSAY: Proceed with Final Reading.

CLERK: (Read LB 202 on Final Reading.)

SENATOR LINDSAY: All requirements relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 202 pass? Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Record vote read. See page 660 of the Legislative Journal.) 41 ayes, 1 nay, 3 present and not voting, 4 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

SENATOR LINDSAY: LB 202 passes. Mr. Clerk, is there a motion on the desk?

CLERK: Mr. President, I do have a motion on the desk Senator Hall would move to change the Speaker's agenda so as to permit consideration of a motion to return LB 36 for a specific amendment.
