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organizations that also might fall in this category. So that's the purpose of the amendment and I would be happy to entertain any questions or would certainly welcome the dialogue that's to follow and your support of the amendment. Thank you very much.

SENATOR WILL: Thank you, Senator Preister. I understand we have a request for a division of the question. Senator Hall.

SENATOR HALL: Yes, Mr. President and members, I would like to have the Preister amendment divided in two parts, the first part being the striking of a nonprofit and where Senator Preister would add "an" in there so that it would read "not to apply to an organization". That would be the first part of the division, and the second part would be the striking of, on line 16, "with regard to any lawful product", and I would argue that it's clearly divisible. I want to ask the Chair to do so.

CLERK: Senator, if I may ask, and then there's in line 15 also Senator Preister has after the word "to" insert the word "in".

SENATOR HALL: That's correct. That would be part of the first...it would follow with the striking of "a nonprofit"...

CLERK: Okay.

SENATOR HALL: ...because that's where the "an" would be inserted, Mr. Clerk, and I believe that's the first division. And the second division would be the striking of the language in line 16 with regard to any lawful product.

SENATOR WILL: Thank you, Senator Hall. I would rule that the amendment is divisible. Senator Preister, which portion of the division would you like to take up first?

SENATOR PREISTER: Thank you, Honorable President. I would take up the first section, the striking of "a nonprofit" and inserting "an".

SENATOR WILL: Discussion on that divided portion of the amendment. Senator Hudkins.

SENATOR HUDKINS: I would like to ask Senator Hall a question, if I may.

SENATOR HALL: Yes.
