

who was, in effect, the catalyst for this type of legislation. The hospital could, in effect, argue that, no, our purpose, our primary purpose or objective is to control, limit or eliminate the use of such lawful product. We are in the business to be a health care provider. They could probably make a very good argument to that effect. The problem is, under this bill, they could still have that policy to sit on the work site. You can't do that. You don't have the ability to do that. But when it comes time to be on your own time, at home, off the job, you cannot limit what that individual employee has the ability to do. What I did do is go pull the U.S. Master Tax Guide and looked up what a 501...Section 501 organization is, and it's a variety of organizations that reads, it says, generally nonprofit groups organized for charitable or mutual benefit purposes, for purposes of receiving income tax exemption. And let me just list to you who they are, and maybe this is...Senator Preister, as a compromise proposal, possibly to insert an organization that falls under Section 501 is the way to handle this. And I'm not opposed to trying to work on this but I...to just list any organization or an organization, I don't think, by any stretch, is a...does that. The problem also with the 501 designation is that it includes the hospital, so it's kind of a Catch 22, if you will, for me. I'm trying to work on this but I also want to make sure that those employers don't fall under the exemption that are listed there. But here, just as an example, it talks about the corporation organized under an act of Congress as a U.S. instrumentality. Talks about a corporation for the exclusive purposes of holding title to property. Talks about a community chest fund foundation organized exclusively and operated exclusively for religious, charitable, scientific, a number of other purposes. That's Section 3. Section 4 says a civic league, an organization not organized for profit but operated exclusively for the promotion of social welfare. A labor, agricultural or horticultural organization is Section 6 of 501. Section 6...excuse me, that was Section 5 of 501. Section 6 says a business league, chamber of commerce, a real estate board, board of trade or a professional football league. That's the group that the President is dealing with right now; 501(7) is a club organized for pleasure, recreation and other nonprofit purposes; 501(8) is fraternal beneficiary society, order or association; 9 is a voluntary employees' beneficiary association, and this goes up to 25; 10 is a domestic fraternal society;...
