SPEAKER WITHEM: Senator Wesely.

SENATOR WESELY: Mr. Speaker, welcome back. The Health and Human Services Committee has for the consideration of the Legislature the nomination of Michael Haller, a doctor from Omaha, who has been appointed to the Rural Health Advisory Commission. The committee recommends approval of his appointment.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Any discussion? No closing, I assume, Senator Wesely? We will proceed with the vote. All those in favor of the confirmation report signify by voting aye, opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of the confirmation report as offered by the Health Committee.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Government Committee, Senator Robinson.

SENATOR ROBINSON: Mr. President, members of the body, I come before you this morning to confirm two members to the Accountability and Disclosure Commission, Judy Tamisiea and Charles J. Dougherty. Both of those folks are from Omaha. And we had a hearing, a unanimous vote to confirm those two folks. So I would move that...move the confirmation of these two.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Any discussion? Senator Robinson, closing? No closing. Question is, shall the confirmation report be adopted? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.
