CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on the adoption of the confirmation report.

SENATOR CROSBY: The report is adopted. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Madam President, the Health Committee reports on appointments to the State Board of Health and the Rural Health Advisory Commission. The report is on page 727 of the Journal.

SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you. Senator Wesely.

SENATOR WESELY: Thank you. Madam President and members of the Legislature, the Health and Human Services Committee did hold hearings regarding the appointments of four individuals to various boards in the Health Department. We recommend their approval. They are Dr. Art Weaver to the State Board of Health, Dr. Richard Tempero to the State Board of Health, Marcia Freer of the Rural Health Advisory Commission and Dr. Michael Sitorius to the Rural Health Advisory Commission. These individuals are all, I think, currently serving in these capacities and we would ask for their approval.
