

body to adopt the committee amendments.

SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you, Senator Withem. For discussion on the committee amendments, Senator Warner, your light is the first light. Senator Wesely. Senator Schimek, on the amendments.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Yes, Madam President. Senator Warner, I just have one question and I don't understand what number 7 on the summary of the committee amendments means. It says, annexation of a project shall not extend the zoning jurisdiction of the annexing city. You can annex this property but you don't have zoning jurisdiction over it then?

SENATOR WARNER: Yes. Under the provisions of...of the act for redevelopment for the work...the site, say, was a section of land, would be annexed into the city but it would not be contiguous as is otherwise required. So it's special permission to annex but what the purpose of the amendment is, is that we make sure that if it was a first class city, they have a mile around that, or if it was Lincoln or Omaha, it would be three miles around. And the idea is that the entity that currently had that zoning jurisdiction could continue to retain it whether it was a county or another municipality unless they agreed to do otherwise.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Okay, I understand. Thank you.

SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you, Senator Schimek. Senator Wesely, you said the bill. All right, Senator Maurstad. Any further discussion on the committee amendments? Seeing none, Senator Warner, would you like to close? He waives closing. The question is the adoption of the committee amendments to LB 830. All those in favor vote aye, opposed no. We're voting on the committee amendments to LB 830. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on adoption of the committee amendments.

SENATOR CROSBY: The committee amendments are adopted. We will now go to the bill itself, LB 830. Senator Withem, to open on LB 830.
