SPEAKER WITHEM: That is certainly my understanding, Senator Beutler.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay, so if the county that's out in this rural area, which is the only authority that has jurisdiction, approves of it, then presumably they have reviewed it from the perspective of the rural areas of the community and it should be all right.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Then I would ask you this. It says within 15 days of the receipt of the application. Is there someplace else in the bill where it says that notice of that application has to go to the county? I mean...

SPEAKER WITHEM: I believe, I believe that part of the work of the Revenue Committee refined that whole process there. And I can't point to specifically...

SENATOR BEUTLER: Sure.

SPEAKER WITHEM: ...in the bill, but there does need to be a generalized process. Mr. Stadtwald is, you know, bringing the...indicates directly above, and I didn't catch your page reference to where you're speaking of, but directly above the portion you're reading...

SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay, I see it.

SPEAKER WITHEM: ...there is that requirement notice.

SENATOR BEUTLER: So they need to file a copy of this at the same time with the county?

SPEAKER WITHEM: Right.

SENATOR BEUTLER: And also with the electric utilities involved in the area.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Correct. Correct.

SENATOR BEUTLER: All right, so the electric utilities can object also.
