This is not a deliberative process that we are engaging in, and it plays into the hands of the Chamber of Commerce and the others who want to get a monumental shift in our policies without the legislators, as a whole, being aware of what actually is being done.

SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you, Senator Chambers. Senator Kristensen on the Coordsen amendment.

Senator Coordsen, I just want to, we had some discussion here and I want to include you and maybe get some of this back on the record so we understand where we are at.
