PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you, Senator Brashear. Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Madam President and members of the Legislature, I've eliminated some words and this is the way this would read and it might be somewhat more intelligible. If the board approves such area application, then the designated blighted and substandard area is considered to be a designated blighted and substandard area and the property within such area is considered to be substandard and blighted property. That's what they're trying to say and I eliminated, for the purposes of Article VIII, section 12, of the Constitution of Nebraska, as applied in the act, then I eliminated one of those as determined by law, then I eliminated a "to be determined by law". I'd like to ask Senator Brashear a question if he will find in his bill the spot we are talking about on page 12?

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Senator Brashear.

SENATOR BRASHEAR: Yes, Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Senator Brashear, do you agree that this is an attempt by the Legislature to notify a court of the Legislature's interpretation of the Constitution as it would apply to the provisions of this law?

SENATOR BRASHEAR: Not to quibble, Senator Chambers, with your language which is very always excellent, I don't think it's a notification to a court, I think it's a binding determination as a matter of public policy

SENATOR CHAMBERS: So you think that we in the legislative branch can dictate to the judicial branch how it should decide an issue, a case or controversy?

SENATOR BRASHEAR: No, I do not, Senator Chambers. What I believe we can do is that we can declare as a matter of public policy within the scope of our authority what is blighted and substandard as we have chosen on behalf of the people to define it and that factual determination is binding upon a court. That is not to say, however, that there will not be subsequent court review of procedure and that kind of thing. But as you know
