

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: That appears to be what it does, yes.

SENATOR HALL: Okay, which is the provision that said if there's no applications it goes away two years away from this past February first and then we insert the new language that you've got in this proposal.

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: Yes.

SENATOR HALL: Okay. When we say, and I'm on your amendment, we say strike AM0594, what are we striking there? I followed the rest of it.

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: I'll tell you what my intention was, was it's the AM0594 is the Wesely amendment that put the sunset in for the entire act. My intention is to do that, rework that language into this.

SENATOR HALL: I'm not...I apologize, Senator Kristensen, but I'm not tracking with you. I mean I see where we're striking Section 33 and I see where we're creating a new Section 33, but when we get down to striking AM0594, I'm not following what we're doing. Is that redundant or is that something else that we're doing that...

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: AM0594, Senator, at least in my intention is, that's the amendment that Senator Wesely that he attached that established the sunset for the act.

SENATOR HALL: This is the same amendment that was adopted earlier this evening?

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: Yes.

SENATOR HALL: Okay, now I got it. Now I'm tracking with you.

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: Okay.

SENATOR HALL: Appreciate that. I was working off the white copy and I thought back to your earlier comments about it seemed like it was yesterday, but I could not understand where point 6 on the amendment worked into the bill. Now I understand it. It would be an E & R change that would strike that amendment. Is that correct? Senator Kristensen, it would be an E & R
