SENATOR CROSBY: One minute.

SENATOR HALL: Thank you, Madam President, members, and I'll speak to the issue but it was the portion of the amendment that I did not understand and could not qualify looking at the white copy of the proposal so I had to ask the question. It was not an intent to oppose the measure but merely to find out what AM0594 was and that's the portion of the Wesely amendment that was adopted earlier today that would now come out in order for this to be adopted. So with that, Madam President, I rise in support of Senator Kristensen's amendment and would urge you'd support it.

SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you, Senator Hall. Senator Wesely, your light is next.

SENATOR WESELY: I want to rise and thank Senator Hall because I made a mistake in drafting the amendment earlier and Senator Kristensen made the mistake of following my amendment because it was drafted inappropriately. What we did was, the amendment we adopted earlier struck Section 33. That really wasn't what we had intended. It was simply to add this language to it, so, Senator Hall, you were right. It did strike the two-year thing which we really didn't want to do. What we're going to try and figure out is how to get Senator Kristensen's language so it adds to this section, not delete this section and I think we've got an amendment up there. I don't know if it gets it done but, Senator Hall, I thank you and, Senator Kristensen, I thank you because we would have made a mistake not to have corrected this.
