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page 41. So this amendment to the Kristensen amendment will take care of that problem. I would ask for its adoption.

SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you, Senator Wesely. You've heard the opening on the Wesely amendment to the Kristensen amendment. Senator Warner, your light is on for discussion on this amendment.

SENATOR WARNER: Madam President, I just rise to support Senator Wesely's amendment because it, in effect, restores the committee amendment on Section 33 which, as has been explained, apparently got wiped out with the earlier amendment, but this will... The reason that was in there as a committee amendment, if the act was not used in the next couple of years, we're designing something here that is primarily meant for one set of circumstances and I think the committee's recommendation for this amendment originally was that if it's not utilized, then perhaps we ought to go back from scratch and look at the whole concept and at some later date, but we were not interested in sunseting if the act was being utilized. Between Senator Kristensen's amendment and the committee amendment and Senator Wesely's motion now, if those are all approved, it would seem like we have a better act and I would urge the body to adopt Wesely's amendment and then Senator Kristensen's amendment as amended.

SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you, Senator Warner. Senator Kristensen. Senator Wesely, there are no further lights. Did you... Senator Wesely waives closing on the Wesely amendment to the Kristensen amendment. The question is, shall the Wesely amendment to the Kristensen amendment be adopted? All in favor vote aye, opposed no. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on adoption of Senator Wesely's amendment.

SENATOR CROSBY: The Wesely amendment is adopted. We are back now to the Kristensen amendment. Discussion on the Kristensen amendment. Seeing none, Senator Kristensen, would you like to close on your amendment?

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: Thank you, Madam President. Members of the Legislature, I hope and I'll look for anybody who will raise some question, but I believe that the condition of the amendment is in right now maintains that sunset that the Revenue Committee
