had put into their amendment and it also adds then as a final sunset, regardless of whether there is any applications or so on, a bright line on February 1, year 2000 that there will be no more applications for area applications or project applications and that will be, unless there is some further action of the Legislature, that will be an absolute sunset of anybody else taking advantage of this project on that date. It also would retain that the act terminates on February 1 of 1997 if there is no applications who have been approved prior to that date. So, in effect, there is a twofold sunset in that. With that I would offer the amendment and I believe that it should make the act a little more palatable and easy to handle. Thank you.

SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you, Senator Kristensen. You've heard the closing. The question is the adoption of the Kristensen amendment to LB 830. All those in favor vote aye, opposed no. Please record, Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: 28 ayes, 0 nays on the adoption of the amendment.

SENATOR CROSBY: The Kristensen amendment is adopted. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Madam President, the next motion I have is by Senator Withem. Senator Withem would move to suspend Rule 6, Section 5 and Rule 7, Section 3 and vote on the advancement of LB 830 without further amendment or debate.

SENATOR CROSBY: Senator Withem.

SPEAKER WITHEM: I believe I will go ahead and run this motion although part of me says maybe I should withdraw it and allow the debate to continue. But there comes a time on things like this where you do have to at least give the body an opportunity to make a decision as to whether it has had enough or whether it wants to continue on. This motion, for some of the newer members here, is a motion that used to be the one that was used to cut off debate. It has not been used as frequently since the advent of the cloture rule. If this motion is successful there will be no further debate, there will be no further amendments and we will vote immediately on advancement of LB 830. If it passes, then the bill will go up to E & R Final. I would hope that the body, at least one or two of us could hang around here to get it reported back in and then we would be operating under
