it's AMO600. What it does is add to the bill the same sunset that we had on LB 830 that that be February 1 of the year 2000, but we learned from our mistake yesterday, and this does not delete the two-year sunset that was put in the bill by the committee that takes effect if nobody applies for these benefits. So it's just added in there that project applications filed on or after the February 1, 2000 date would not be authorized in the future and that existing project applications and agreements that were approved prior to that would continue in full force and effect so it reflects the language of Senator Kristensen and the language of Senator Warner and Senator Withem as well. So again, it's a sunset clause. If there are any questions please let me know and I'd ask for your support for the adoption of this amendment.
