

February 23, 1995 LB 828, 829

Senator Warner's amendment.

SENATOR CROSBY: The Warner amendment is adopted.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill at this time, Madam President.

SENATOR CROSBY: Senator Maurstad.

SENATOR MAURSTAD: Madam President, I would move to advance LB 829 to E & R for engrossing.

SENATOR CROSBY: You've heard the motion. There are no lights on for discussion. Senator Withem, would you like to close before...

SPEAKER WITHEM: I would request a call of the house. I believe I heard a number of other individuals ask for a roll call vote. I would suggest that be in reverse order, but I would like a call of the house, please, and I will waive the remainder of my closing.

SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you. There is a request for a call of the house. All in favor vote aye, opposed no. Record, please.

CLERK: 6 ayes, 0 nays to go under call.

SENATOR CROSBY: The house is under call. Would all senators please take their seats and record their presence. Would all unauthorized personnel please leave the floor. Senator Bohlke, would you like to check in. Senator Witek, Senator Robak and Senator McKenzie, the house is under call. The question is...there has been a request for a roll call vote in reverse order and the question is to advance to E & R engrossing of LB 829. Mr. Clerk.
