SENATOR CROSBY: Senator Maurstad.

SENATOR MAURSTAD: Madam President, I would move to adopt the E & R amendments to LB 828.

SENATOR CROSBY: You've heard the motion to adopt the E & R amendments to LB 828. All in favor say aye. Opposed no. They are adopted.

CLERK: Madam President, Senators Janssen and Beutler would move to amend. (See AM0634 found on page 866 of the Legislative Journal.)

SENATOR CROSBY: Senator Janssen.

SENATOR JANSSEN: Madam President, members, I hate to add another amendment to this. The only...the amendment that I have requested by my district which would be the...which has a municipal power company in it. It also protects cities such as Hastings, Grand Island and Lincoln. They've all expressed some concerns over this and what it would do is add, has the amendment been distributed? It adds municipality. It would read in order to help stimulate economic development, any municipality furnishing electric service may, but shall not be required to, and so on. That's the only thing it does. The rest of the amendments that have been put on are all intact. They feel as though there is a problem with this. If an industry would come into say the City of Grand Island, Hastings or Fremont, this they would feel would protect them that they would be able to furnish the same types incentives. Everything else stays the same, I didn't touch anything else. That's the only thing that we would do. The amendment contains the same language as in LB 828, includes all the amendments that were adopted on General File. If Senator Beutler would like to add to that, I think I've covered everything there is. Senator Beutler.
