districts organized under Chapter 70, Article 6 which are organizations such as OPPD and NPPD. All this amendment does is make it applicable also to municipal electrical organizations such as the Fremont municipal system. The language parallels exactly the language that is applicable to OPPD and NPPD so it's the very same thing except you're adding municipals to the group of utilities that are able to benefit or to give the incentive rates and of course it is tied into the Job Qualities Act just as it is for OPPD and NPPD.

SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you, Senator Beutler. Senator Beutler, your light was on. Did you want to go on? Any further discussion of the Janssen amendment to LB 828? Seeing none, Senator Janssen, would you like to close?

SENATOR JANSSEN: Only to say that I hope for the advancement of the amendment. It does nothing else to the bill but provides the municipalities that I represent the power to enter into this agreement should the occasion ever occur. That will be all.

SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you, Senator Janssen. You've heard the closing. The question is the adoption of the Janssen amendment to LB 828. All in favor vote aye, opposed no. Record, please.

ASSISTANT CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays on the adoption of the amendment.

SENATOR CROSBY: The amendment is adopted.

SENATOR CROSBY: Senator Maurstad.

SENATOR MAURSTAD: Madam President, I would move to advance LB 828 to E & R for engrossing.

SENATOR CROSBY: You've heard the motion to advance LB 828 to E & R engrossing. All in favor say aye. We have a request for a machine vote from Senator Hall, so the question is to advance LB 828 to E & R engrossing. All in favor vote aye, opposed no. Request for a record vote. Record, please.
