SPEAKER WITHEM: Right.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Any school could be, I mean a school could be within the blighted, substandard area too, could be declared...okay, let me back up. In declaring an area blighted and substandard, a school could be included in that area that has been so declared.

SPEAKER WITHEM: A school building could be included with...you're talking about a building now as opposed to...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Yes, right...

SPEAKER WITHEM: ...a school district. Okay.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Right, a school building.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Certainly. A school building could be physically within...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: That area.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Right.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: And that school building would be blighted and substandard too, wouldn't it?

SPEAKER WITHEM: It would be part of that area, yes.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Well with the language that we adopted, we said that not only is the area considered blighted and sub...well let me read this.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Senator Chambers, while you're looking that up, if I could comment...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Sure.

SPEAKER WITHEM: I think Senator Beutler had an amendment dealing with eminent domain as it relates to public land and maybe...

SENATOR CROSBY: One minute.
