

training level, below their education level, below their competency level, and below the level of wages and benefits that they are due. I think what will happen is if a Micron comes in, if they have the type of jobs they've talked about, the better paying jobs...

PRESIDENT ROBAK: One minute.

SENATOR WESELY: ...with health care benefits and other types of benefits, they will find the employees. They will find them from other companies in the State of Nebraska that are, I believe, underpaying and with low benefits or no benefits for their employees, and those employees are going to move up to a job that might be offered by a Micron. I see the consequence of Micron coming, not so much that they won't find employees, as that the employees will come from other Nebraska businesses who will then become unhappy and request of us assistance to try to deal with whatever dislocation problems they have. So I don't see the problem with Micron getting employees. I see the problem of its consequences with other businesses and that was the point I was trying to make last week, that we will have the Snyder Industries and others, and they already have come to us saying we need help and assistance to attract employees into the State of Nebraska. And I guess there is already some legislation in to do that, but that's an important distinction to make. Good paying jobs with good benefits are going to get good employees in the State of Nebraska. But we don't have a lot of unemployed people sitting around waiting for an opportunity, and so...

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Time.

SENATOR WESELY: ...there will be consequences to other businesses as a result of that injection of jobs.
