the National Conference of State Legislatures is here. Mr. Pound, would you please stand to be recognized. Thank you. Senators, please check in. Senator Schellpeper, Senator Cudaback. We are waiting for Senator Schellpeper. There has been a request for a roll call vote. Mr. Clerk, please proceed.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken. See page 929 of the Legislative Journal.) 26 ayes, 17 nays on the advancement.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: LB 65 advances. LB 93. I raise the call.

CLERK: Senator Maurstad, E & R amendments to LB 93, Senator, first of all.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Senator Maurstad.

SENATOR MAURSTAD: Madam President, I would move to adopt the E & R amendments.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Is there any discussion on the adoption of the E & R amendments? Seeing none, all those in favor say aye. All those opposed nay. The amendments are adopted.

CLERK: Madam President, Senator Bernard-Stevens would move to indefinitely postpone the bill.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: The Chair recognizes Senator Bernard-Stevens.

SENATOR BERNARD-STEVENS: Thank you, Madam President, and members of the body. Senator Hartnett, I think what...
